SCHWEISSEN & SCHNEIDEN at Messe Essen on September 16 - 21

Cooperative Booths Will Present Important Innovations Focus on Thermal Spraying as Well as on Innovative Young Companies

At the world's premier fair SCHWEISSEN & SCHNEIDEN, around 1,000 international exhibitors will introduce their most important innovations in joining, cutting and surfacing technology on September 16 - 21, 2013. At Messe Essen, trade visitors will be able to experience product premieres and to gain a comprehensive overview of the sectoral innovations from around 40 nations.

On the occasion of its 18th edition, the features on offer at this year's SCHWEISSEN & SCHNEIDEN will include two cooperative subject booths: Thus, not only companies dealing with thermal spraying technology but also young, innovative firms will be given the chance to make their own presentations.

On Booth A 120 in Hall 5, 13 member companies of GTS - Gemeinschaft Thermisches Spritzen e.V. ("Association of Thermal Sprayers") will present their newest developments - including nine German companies, three Swiss companies and one Dutch company. On around 200 square metres, they will show how efficient and diversely applicable thermal spraying technology is. With the various processes which are combined under this term, it is possible to surface the most diverse materials such as metals, ceramic, plastic, textiles, wood or glass. Areas of application are, for example, the manufacture of turbine blades, sealing rings and printing rollers. The objects which can be seen on the subject booth at SCHWEISSEN & SCHNEIDEN will include thermal spraying torches, innovative coating systems for agriculture and the automotive sector as well as turnkey installations for surfacing.

Innovative Company Founders Will Demonstrate Their Efficiency

In Hall 9, an area of around 140 square metres (Booths A 133 - A 145) will be reserved for seven young companies and their innovative portfolios. The exhibited technologies will cover the entire spectrum of joining technology. The exhibits will include, for example, welding gap clamps for root welding, special nozzles and mobile lasers which can also be utilised on ships or drilling rigs. The appearances of the companies will be promoted by the Federal Ministry of Economic Affairs.
